<p>Main Topics (What main ideas/concepts will be covered?):</p> <p>Modes of communication: listening, reading, interpersonal communication, speaking and writing. Intercultural standards: culture, connections, comparisons and communities. Students will build on the concepts learned in Spanish I.</p>	<p>Rationale (Why should a student take this course?)</p> <p>It fulfills the college entrance requirement and the need to communicate with the growing Hispanic population.</p>	<p>Reading (Text, document, etc):</p> <p>Students will read daily in Spanish using the textbook and teacher generated materials. They will complete assignments and read directions in Spanish.</p>	<p>Written (Terms, questions, outlines, free response, etc):</p> <p>Students will be responsible for writing short essays in Spanish. They will write daily in Spanish practicing grammatical structures and vocabulary. They will ask and answer written and oral questions.</p>
