Benefits of AP

33% of students who attend college attain a Bachelor's degree.

59% of students who take at least one AP course attain a Bachelor's degree (regardless of AP exam score)

76% of students who take two or more AP courses attain a Bachelor's degree (regardless of AP exam score)

Lincoln's AP Program

Colleges rank “Grades in college prep courses” and “Strength of curriculum” as the top two factors in the admission decision.*

85% of selective colleges and universities report that a student's AP experience favorably impacts admission decisions.**
