## Sexual Harassment, Teen Dating Violence and Abuse and Hazing Training Procedures

2021-2022

All Leon County Schools' teachers, students, administrators, and support staff are required to be trained on sexual harassment awareness. The policy requires that this training be completed on an annual basis. Everyone is expected to <u>sign off</u> documenting that he/she has viewed the required training video/DVD.

In addition to the aforementioned, each school/site is expected to do the following and submit it to the Office of Prevention, Intervention and Equity – Attention: Dr. Kathleen Rodgers, Assistant Superintendent.

- Designate a Sexual Harassment Complaint person. This name should be submitted by Friday, <u>October</u> 8, 2021.
- 2. Training for all employees is now online! Access the Leon County Schools website and go to the Equity and Diversity webpage to view the sexual harassment training video. All teachers, administrators and support staff sexual harassment training must be completed by Friday, October 8, 2021. <sup>1.</sup> See also <sup>4.</sup> below for Anti-hazing information. District staff will download the file of everyone who viewed the video by cost center.
- 3. Submit documentation of all student sexual harassment and bullying training by Friday, **December 3**, **2021**. (Secondary <sup>2</sup>.) and (Elementary <sup>3</sup>).
- 4. Submit documentation of all student teen dating violence and abuse training<sup>2</sup>, bullying, and hazing training<sup>4</sup> by Friday, <u>December 3, 2021</u> (Secondary).
- 5. In reference to number three (3), documentation should include the following:
  - a. Name of School;
  - b. Date video/DVD was shown or class conducted;
  - c. Title of Video/DVD or curriculum used;
  - d. The attendance printout of all students in attendance on the day the training was conducted; and
  - e. Principal's <u>original</u> signature on a cover sheet confirming the annual training took place.
