

Criteria for Admission
to the
National Honor Society
of
Amos P. Godby High School

Information sheets will be given out to qualified students in the spring after transcripts are completed. Membership is open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors.

1. A *3.60 weighted* cumulative GPA. This includes ALL classes reported on the school's official transcript. The classes MUST lead to an academic diploma. A minimum of two honors courses must be taken each semester.
2. No "D's" or "F's" on the current school year's nine week's grades.
3. If a "D" or "F" appears on the transcript it will be one year before an invitation for membership is issued. No other "D's" or "F's" shall appear during this period.
4. Good citizenship. No more than one "2" or "1" in citizenship during any term.
5. Good attendance and behavior. No referrals in Student Services or Attendance offices.
6. Enrollment at Amos P. Godby High School for at least one semester.
7. Faculty recommendation based on categories of scholarship, leadership, service, and character.
8. Submission of an information sheet.
9. Approval by faculty committee based on the above requirements.
10. Attend a mandatory meeting with your parent(s) to learn the responsibilities that accompany membership.
11. Must have completed prior to induction, at least 25 hours of community service for juniors and at least 45 hours of community service for seniors. These must be posted on your record in Guidance prior to induction. This serves as verification for the selection procedure.
