



Fairview Softball Team Letter



Congratulations on making the Fairview Falcon softball team. We look forward to a spectacular season! Below is important information to ensure this is a successful season.

Attendance - Attendance at all practices and games is mandatory. Timely pickup from practice and games is required. A coach must be contacted upon the student being absent from a practice. Parents may provide a written note or doctor's note for absences. Teachers may also excuse students for academic purposes. Students and parents can arrange carpools to meet the timely pickup requirement. Unexcused absences and untimely pickups from a practice or game may result in shortened playing time, loss of starting position, or removal from the team.

Team Fees - The team fee is \$40 and must be received by Friday, March 16, 2018. The team fee covers the following

- Meals before games
- Award banquet at Fun Station (dinner and games)
- Shirt*
- Trophy
- Hoodie/jacket*

- Socks
- Sunglasses

Playing Time and Participation – Playing time is not guaranteed. Dugout participation (cheering) is required. This is a competitive sport and league. Coaches will make decisions on playing time based on

- athlete in-school behavior/academics
- the level of the competition
- athlete skill at a certain position
- the best opportunity to win the game

Athletes are expected to remain positive at all times and support the players on the field with cheers from the dugout.

Infractions

Participating on the Fairview softball team is a privilege. If the student-athlete cannot represent their team and themselves in a respectable manner, this privilege will be taken away. In order to reach the team's full potential, the individual will be responsible for the following criteria.

- Students must positively represent the team on and off the field.
- Fairview softball students must maintain a 2.0 grade point average.
- Athletes must demonstrate sportsmanship during all games.

Schedule – All games take place at the BelleVue Fields (2214 Belle Vue Way) at 6:00 PM. A schedule is on the back of this letter. We will also attend one FSU game on March 6 at 6:00 PM.
