



Writing Effective Web Content – Venn Diagram



Note

Think about a report you recently wrote for school. You may consider using documents created in other activities in this course, such as the **Favorite Sport Report** or the team **Cyberbullying 10-Tip Plan** activities.

You may wish to print or save their finished document.

In this activity, you will create a Venn diagram that compares effective print content to effective Web content.

1. Think about a report you recently wrote for school.
2. If you were to post the information from that report on the Internet, what text aids would you consider adding to your page? (For example, keywords, headings, images, and so forth.)
3. Create a Venn diagram using a word-processing program or an online program such as the one found at [readwritethink.org](http://www.readwritethink.org/files/resources/interactives/venn_diagrams/) (http://www.readwritethink.org/files/resources/interactives/venn_diagrams/).
4. Use the diagram to compare and contrast the content used on Web pages with the content used on traditionally printed pages.
