

## **Cyberbullying 10-Tip Plan**



## Note

In this activity, students will form teams of three to four students each. Each team member will be asked to create a definition for cyberbullying. The resulting definitions will then be used to create a 10-Tip Plan for display near computers.

You may wish to revise Step 6 to include word-processing software.

Consider having each team present their plan and then have students vote on the best plan. Alternatively, you can use each team's plan to create a "master" plan.

The Advanced Cyberbullying 10-Tip Plan builds on this activity.

In this activity, you will form teams to define cyberbullying and identify realistic ways to counteract it.

- 1. Form teams of three to four students each.
- 2. In your teams, create a definition for cyberbullying.
- 3. Identify key words or phrases that describe the acts, the methods, the consequences and the counteractions of cyberbullying.
- 4. Discuss all members' definitions and ideas among your team.
- 5. Choose key points from each team member to make one overall definition.
- 6. Choose key points from each team member to create 10 tips for counteracting cyberbullying. You can display this 10-Tip Plan near all school computers.

Examples might include:

- Treat others with respect.
- Keep passwords secret.
- If you do not want the world to know, then do not post it!
- Never post personal information online that can identify you in any way.
