



Validating a Web Site's Code



In this activity, you will use the W3C's Markup Validation Service to validate your school Web site's code.

1. Visit your school's Web site. Write down the Web address, or copy the address by highlighting it in the address bar and pressing CTRL+C on your keyboard.
2. Open a new browser window.
3. Go to the W3C Markup Validation Service page at <http://validator.w3.org/>.
4. Make sure that the Validate By URI section is displayed, then type your school's Web address into the Address box or paste it by pressing CTRL+V.
5. Verify that the Web address is correct, and then click the Check button.
6. Review the results.
7. If the validator reports errors, see if you can determine the solutions by searching online.

Note: If the Web page validated with no errors, then validate another Web page you visit frequently. Create a list of two or three errors and their possible solutions.
