



# Choosing a Domain Name



In this activity, you will suggest domain names for a company.

Consider the following scenario:

William Jackson, owner of The T-Shirt Factory, loved your design ideas for his Web site. He would now like you to help him choose a domain name for the site. The T-Shirt Factory is located in Atlanta, Georgia and is the largest reseller of pre-designed and custom T-shirts.

1. Using the guidelines introduced in this lesson, create a list of suggested domain names for The T-Shirt Factory.
2. Visit the InterNIC website's WHOIS page at [www.internic.net/whois.html](http://www.internic.net/whois.html) and search for the domain names on your list. If one is unavailable, continue down the list.
3. Make note of any alternative domain names as you think of them. Also note the top-level domains (TLDs) given at the top of the page.
4. List two or three available domain names. **Do not actually register a domain name.**
