



# Creating a Digital Bill of Rights



In this activity, you will create a "Bill of Rights" document to specify ways that Internet users can be responsible citizens of an online society.

- Form groups of two to four students.
- Create a Digital Bill of Rights that answers this question: How can you be a good digital citizen?
- Choose one focus. For example: Explain why it is important to follow Internet safety guidelines, practice safe online gaming or protect your reputation online.
- Use the Web tools of your choice to create a photo story, podcast, screencast, tips sheet, slideshow, word-processing document or video that presents your Digital Bill of Rights.
- Your presentation should demonstrate your knowledge about the focus topic you chose. Make it creative and unique. Be sure to properly cite any sources.
