- Assignments must be **complete** to receive credit. ALL problems must be worked out.
- Each homework assignment will be graded out of 5 points. The scoring rubric is:

5	All questions answered, all work shown, ON TIME
1-4	All questions answered, all work shown, one point lost for every day late
0	List of answers (no work shown) Not all problems have been attempted I’m unable to read your submission

X	Nothing submitted; treated as a 0 in the gradebook
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Tests and Quizzes:

- Tests will always be announced several days ahead of time and vary in point value.
- Cheating on a test will result in a grade of zero.
- Corrections will be offered. (SUPER helpful, 10/10 would recommend) still working on specifics here...
