Upon completion of the course, the credit/grade is entered into Focus.

A grade of "C" (70%) or higher is required to earn credit for the course. All lessons and other required work must be completed to earn credit. (Students must verify completion of course with teacher)

CLASS REGISTRATION INFORMATION: Please read carefully!

- ***Summer classes will be held Monday through Thursday June 3-June 25.***
- *Course work started during the summer, but not finished, can be completed in the fall. Coursework is kept for 12 months from the last date the student enrolled. Credit is issued when coursework is completed and graded by teacher. Students must attend daily or risk being dropped from the course.*
- *Students who register after the class has started need to be aware that it is very difficult to finish a half credit even when working for the entire summer session.*
