1. How was fighting in the Spanish-American War difficult for the Rough Riders?

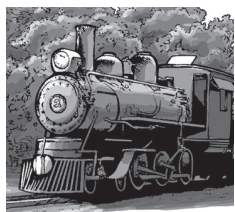
2. How did Julia Tuttle feel about Henry Flagler's ideas for developing south Florida?

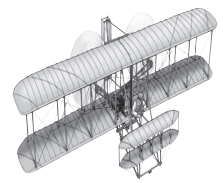
